SUBJECT: Public Hearing on Private Transfer Fee Covenants

The Title Insurance (C) Task Force will hold a public hearing on private transfer fee covenants at the **NAIC Fall National Meeting in Orlando, Florida**. The public hearing is scheduled for Sunday, October 17, 2010, from 1:00–3:00 PM EDT at the Gaylord Palms Hotel and Convention Center.

This hearing is intended to provide an opportunity for members and interested parties to share their views and provide insight into private transfer fee covenants. The information will be used to provide information to the Title Insurance (C) Task Force to consider whether or not a position should be taken in regard to private transfer fee covenants.

Please let us know if you plan to attend and if you want to testify. If you plan to testify, you must submit an electronic copy of your testimony in Microsoft Word format by the end of the business day October 8, 2010. To attend a single session at the NAIC Fall National Meeting:
