Below are a few comments from Colorado.

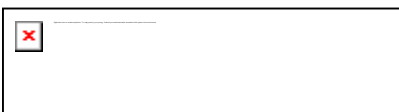
1. We would like to see all terminations included in the data call. Currently only refusal to write is included; however, we would like to see cancellations and non-renewals included.

2. From our actuaries:

This proposal would be useful in that the data call will collect data that Colorado does not currently collect such as (number of applicants, number of refusals to write etc.) and also provide data that Colorado currently collects but at a more granular (ZIP code) level. We would like clarification of who analyzes the data. Does the state analyze it or does the NAIC analyze it on the state's behalf?
