If it's not too late (if it is, then disregard), I'd suggest the following:

****E-mail subject****

I didn't find a suggested change to the subject line, but "MAWG Agenda" would not catch my attention. I'd suggest, if possible, something along the lines of:

"<state abbreviation> Domestic MAWG Referral Notice"

Even if you can't insert the state abbreviation easily, some sort of information that the message contains a MAWG referral would be more helpful.

****Recipients****

I'd suggest that both the MAC and CAD of the referring and domiciliary states be cc'd on the referral notice. While the MAC of the referring state should be aware of the referral, it's possible in some larger states that MARS approval may be delegated to subordinates - so it would be helpful to make sure the referring MAC is in the loop.
