

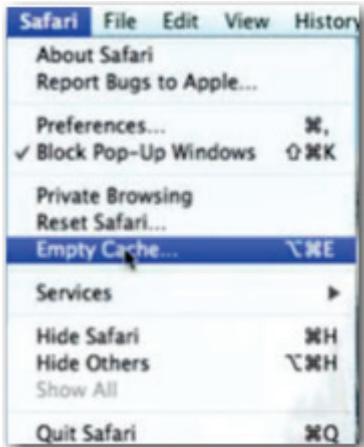

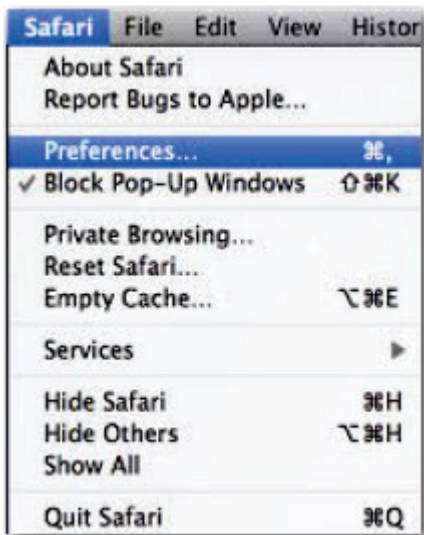
## CLEARING THE BROWSER TEMPORARY INTERNET FILES (CACHE)

- Open Safari
- Click on the Safari option in the menu (you may need to minimize your Safari window to see this)
- Select empty cache

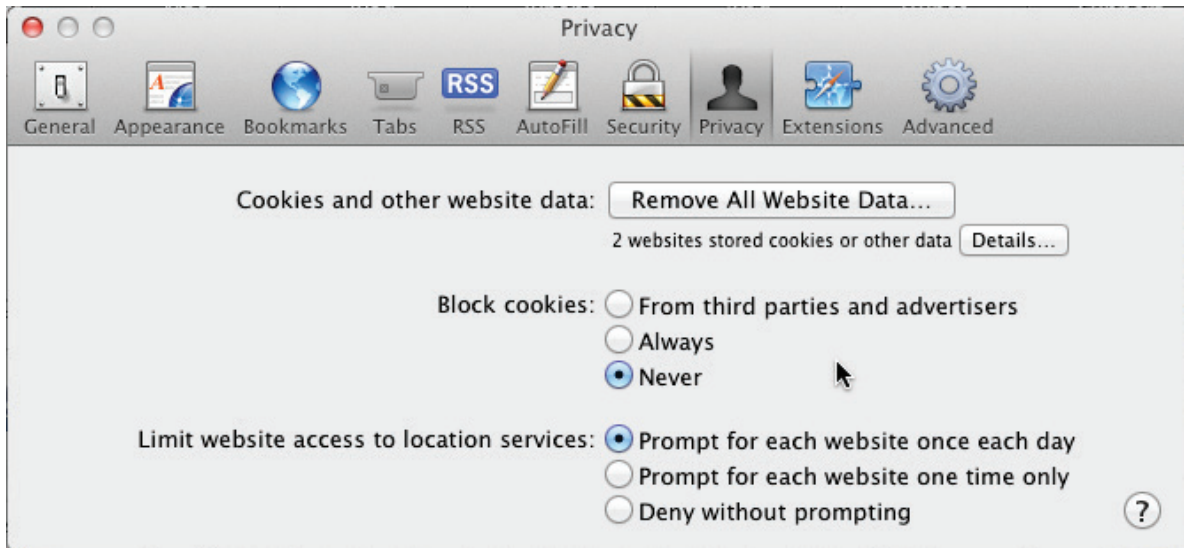


## COOKIE SETTINGS AND DELETING COOKIES

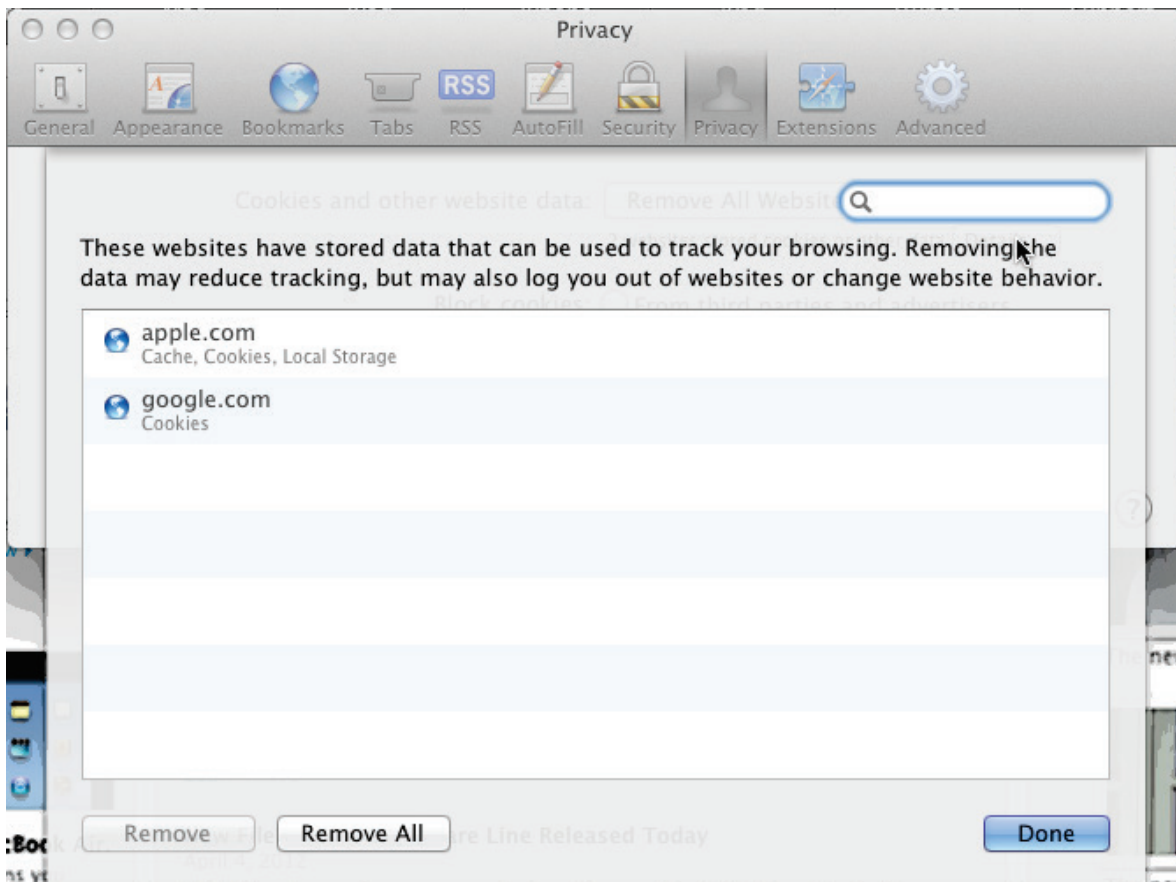
- Go to the Safari option in the menu at the top of the screen (you may need to minimize your Safari window to see this)
- Select Preferences



- Select the Privacy Icon at the top of the menu
- Under block cookies select never



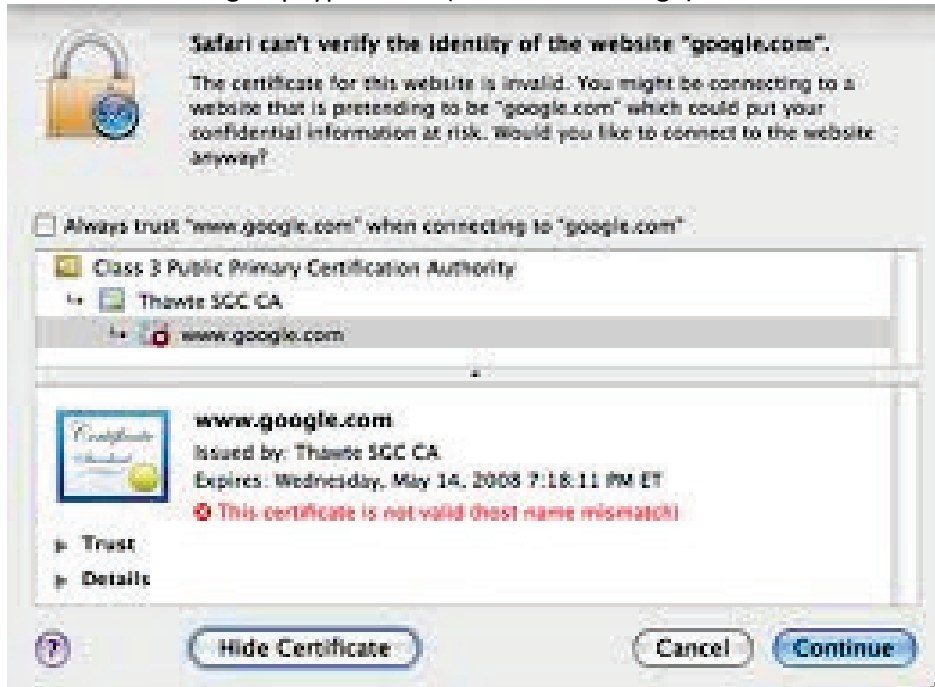
- To clear cookies select the “Details...” button
- Click the “Remove All” button
- Click the “Done” button
- Close the menu



- Go to the Safari option in the menu at the top of the screen and select quit Safari

- Open Safari
- To insure that your browser is able to access PayPal (NIPR/NAIC payment vendor)
  - Go to [www.paypal.com](http://www.paypal.com)
  - If you get a message similar to the one below please select “Always Trust [www.paypal.com](http://www.paypal.com) when connecting to paypal.com” (or similar message) and click continue.
