

NAIC Meeting Site Selection Policy

Several factors impact the choice of location for the NAIC's quarterly national meetings. Site selection is limited to hotels/convention centers that can accommodate more than 1,600 attendees. In addition, the NAIC tries to hold national meetings in each of the four NAIC zones (West, Midwest, Northeast, Southeast) every year. Because sites are selected five years in advance, the NAIC is able to negotiate substantially reduced hotel room rates. The NAIC also offers zone and grant funds to the state insurance departments to help offset travel costs.
