

Robert Dineen Award for Outstanding Service and Contribution to the State Regulation of Insurance

INFORMATION REQUIRED FOR NOMINATIONS:

1. The specific contribution of the nominee stated in a single sentence.
2. Present position (title, organization, address); positions (past and present) in which the nominee made the contribution.
3. How the contribution was implemented. Please cite specifics.
4. The actual demonstrated impact of the contribution.
5. Whether the contribution was developed alone or together with others (name any others).
6. The probable future impact of the contribution.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

- Currently serving as full time staff of a state insurance department, and
- Has contributed a singularly significant concept of practice that sets a new standard in the area of state regulation of insurance, or
- Has individually produced research which makes an original and significant contribution to state regulation of insurance, or
- Achieves the most effective regulatory program at the optimum cost over the longest term, or
- Exhibits an attitude and performs activities fostering the advancement of the insurance regulatory profession, or
- Has made an outstanding contribution to the literature of insurance.

SELECTION PROCESS:

1. Nominations will be received from any commissioner/director/superintendent or full time staff member of a state insurance department.
2. A detailed explanation of the nominee's contribution must accompany the nomination.
3. Nominations will be sent to the NAIC Executive Vice President and CEO by November 1 of each year.
4. Those nominations adjudged by the NAIC President and President-Elect to be consistent with the selection criteria will then be presented to the Special Selection Committee consisting of the four Zone chairs, the President, President-Elect, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer.
5. The candidate receiving a majority of the votes of the members of the Special Selection Committee is judged to be selected.
6. Presentation of the award will be made annually at the Opening Session of the December NAIC meeting.

NATURE OF THE AWARD:

A plaque will be presented to the honoree at the Opening Session of the NAIC's December Winter National Meeting, and a permanent plaque recognizing the honorees will be maintained at the NAIC Executive Headquarters in Kansas City.
