



The NAIC is pleased to provide State Webinar or On-Site Training for Company Licensing Best Practices in conjunction with the Expansion and Corporate Amendments Electronic Applications Process.

UCAAA is the streamlined process of company licensing. The insurer licensing process encompasses the initial licensing of an insurer as well as licensing in additional states (Expansion), and other filings that modify an existing Certificate of Authority (Corporate Amendment). The electronic version of UCAA takes the uniformity of the paper version and transfers it into the ease of an online application. Uniform requirements and state specific requirements are readily available to the Applicant via the NAIC website, which reduces frequent calls to the admissions coordinator, financial analyst or examiners within the departments of insurance.
