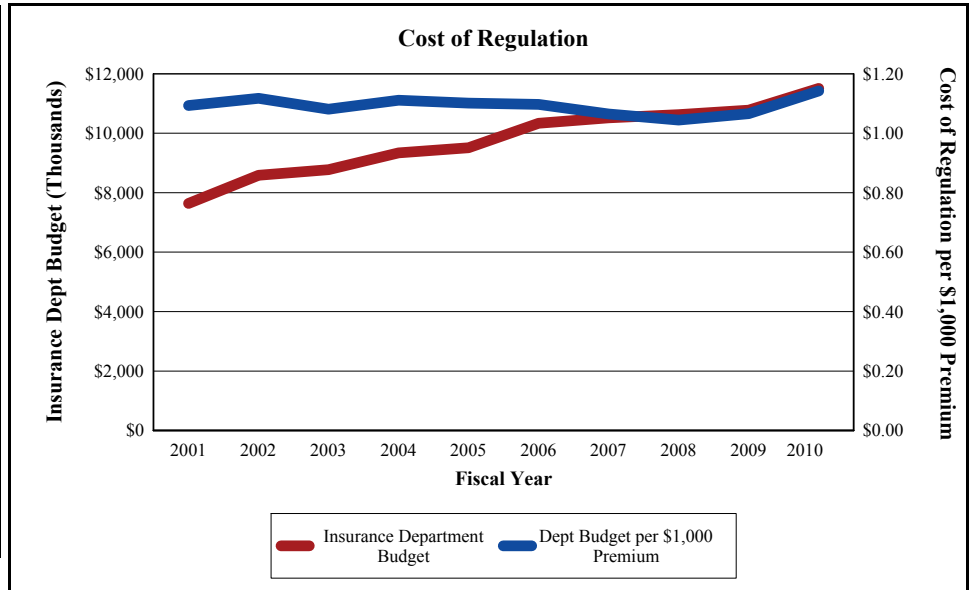

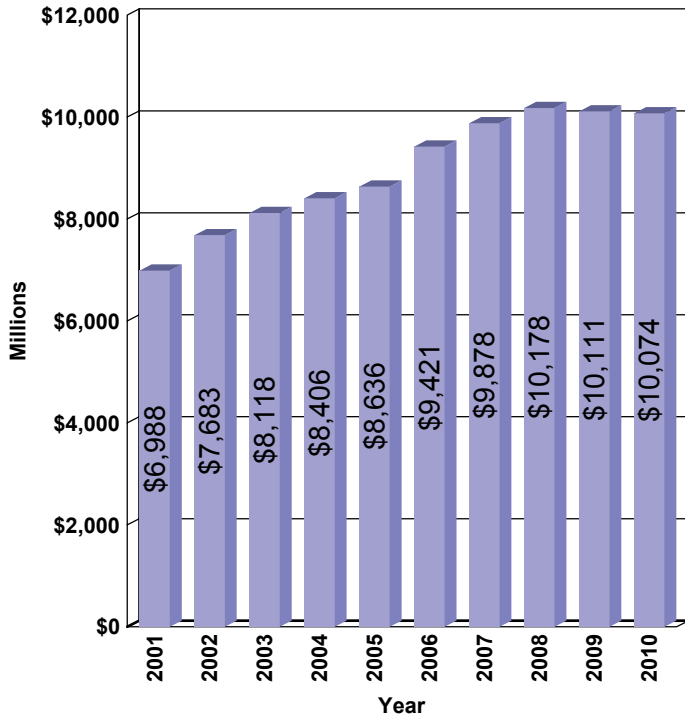

All Types of Insurance



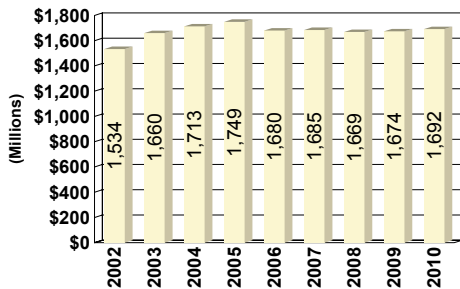

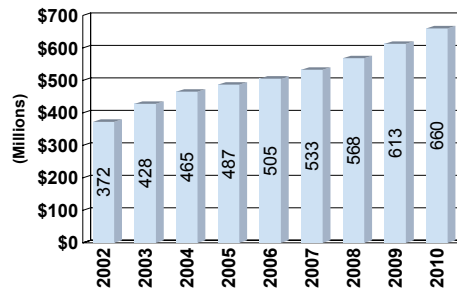

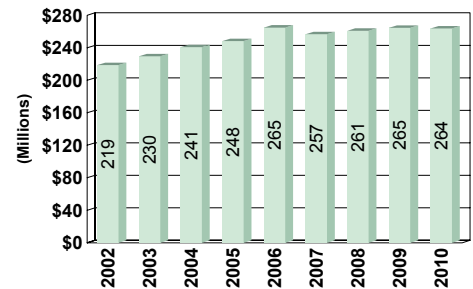
Premium Written for Automobile Insurance



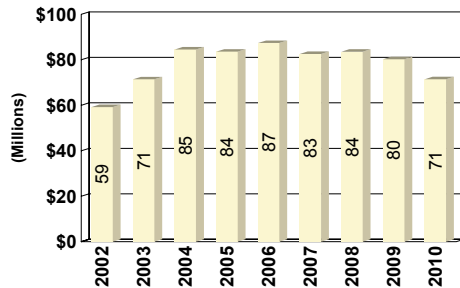
Premium Written for Homeowners Insurance



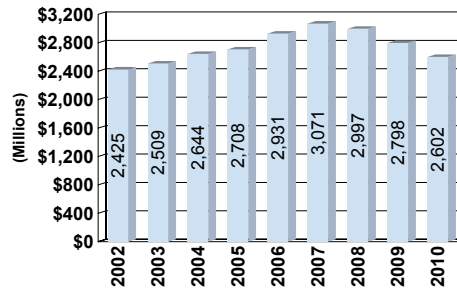
Premium Written for Commercial MP Insurance



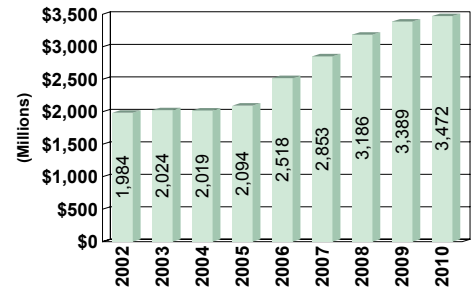
Premium Written for Medical Liability Insurance
