As multinational insurers continue expanding across borders, regulators around the world are responding by collaborating to ensure effective supervision and stable markets. The *International Insurance Forum* is designed for individuals determined to understand the impact of international supervisory developments for the U.S. supervisory framework.

Effects of the global financial and economic crisis still influence the insurance sector, and work continues to enhance insurance supervision. The creation of common standards and enhanced coordination continues, and regulatory frameworks advance to keep pace with evolving business models. The 2014 *Forum* will continue to focus on the extensive engagement of U.S. state-based insurance regulators working collaboratively with counterparts around the world. Together, they are developing internationally accepted best practices for supervising multinational insurers, conducting supervisory colleges, and assisting emerging insurance markets.

Presenters will include U.S. chief insurance regulators, international insurance regulators, federal financial regulators and industry leaders. Members of international standard setting bodies such as the International Association of Insurance Supervisors (IAIS), Financial Stability Board (FSB) and the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) will also be invited to contribute to the Forum.
